

Removal of SECOP Mark on Compressor Housing Top Cover

With the introduction of new Secop product platforms from the end of 2022, Secop has decided to remove the SECOP mark stamping from the top half cover of the compressor housing to avoid confusion between different product platforms related to stationary cooling applications on the market.

Timing

Secop will implement the top half cover of the compressor housing without the SECOP stamping on the N-Series from March 2023 and on the S-Series from April 2023. The detailed changes can be seen in Figure 1 and 2.

Approvals

This change has no effect on product function, performance, or approvals. The stamping codes corresponding to model and production date on the compressor housing next to the nameplate will remain the same.
